Rules and Regulations

All ponies must be registered by the closing date of entries in the appropriate section of the BCPS Stud Book or Register, in the Stud Book of an Approved Connemara Society or in the Part-Bred Register where applicable.

A copy of the BCPS Showing Rules is available on the BCPS website, www.britishconnemaras.co.uk It is the responsibility of Exhibitors to enter ponies correctly in the appropriate class. Neither the organisers of this event nor the BCPS nor any agent or representative thereof accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness or any loss of any kind whether financial or otherwise suffered by any horse, pony, owner, rider, spectator, land building, person, animal or any other property of any type whether caused by negligence, breach of trust, or in any way whatsoever.

It is a condition of entry that all exhibitors shall, to the extent allowed by law, indemnify this Show and Officials, Servants and Assistants against all actions, proceeding, claims or otherwise in relation to or arising from his/her entries in this show, and each entry form must be signed as having accepted these conditions.

Objections: Any person wishing to lodge a protest with reference to any person or exhibit shall do so in writing within 30 minutes of the termination of the class, and at the same time shall deposit a sum of £50.00. If on investigation by the organisers the protest is not sustained the deposit shall be forfeited.

Broodmares: Must be free of hereditary diseases. All in-milk mares must be shown with the foal at foot and no foal is to be exhibited under four weeks of age.

Timetable: Exhibitors are asked to note the timetable. The Committee reserves the right to divide, cancel or amalgamate any class where deemed necessary

TO BE RUN UNDER NPS SCOTLAND FINALS (BLAIR CASTLE) RULES 2024 which are on the NPS Scotland website www.npsscotland.co.uk These rules clarify areas particular to NPS Scotland. We also run to the Rules of the NPS and again these can be found on our website. Exhibitors are deemed to be conversant with these rules. There are new rules this year so please be vigilant and read them.

This show is a qualifier for **The NPS Scotland/Townhead Pet N Pony In Hand Mountain & Moorland Championship Final, The NPS Scotland Kilmannan Novice Ridden Mountain & Moorland Championship, The NPS Scotland/Baileys Horse Feeds Open Ridden Mountain & Moorland Championship, the NPS Scotland/ Maggie May Junior Open Ridden Championship, and the NPS Scotland/Kingfisher Building Products Mountain & Moorland Open WHP Championship.**

National Pony Society Mountain and Moorland Qualifying Round Breed Show Rules:

These classes are judged under the rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Studbooks. Part-Breds are not eligible for M&M Classes.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members and at breed shows ponies can qualify for finals even if their owners are not members. Owners of qualified ponies must become adult qualifying of Life members to enter the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern NPS Summer Championships 2024 – 6th – 8th August 2024

The Tam O'Shanter In Hand Championship

This show is a qualifier for the Tam O'Shanter In Hand Championship to be held at the annual BCPS Breed Show on 19th July 2024 at Moreton Morrell, Warwick, CV35 9BL. The 3 highest placed ponies not already qualified for the finals will qualify, qualification to go no lower than 6th place

Caledonian Showing Championships

This show is a qualifier for the Caledonian Showing Championships, which offers competitors the opportunity to compete at a top level Championship Final in Scotland. With a draped main arena, amazing rosettes, special prizes, music, judges from the south and atmospheric Evening Performances, this is the show everyone wants to be part of

This year's show will be held at *Highfield @ Howe, near Ladybank, Fife on 18th-20th October 2024*

Every horse & pony placed 1st in all Inhand, Ridden Showing classes (not fun classes) & Working Hunter/Pony classes will qualify to compete in any appropriate class at the Finals. All Champions & Reserves will qualify for the Champion & Reserves Stakes Finals. Qualification will be from placings, no qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, and no qualification can go down the line.

All qualified horses and ponies will be listed on the Caledonian Showing Championship Show's website www.caledonianchampionships.webs.com

There will be no specific First Aider in attendance, however there will be a number of first Aiders on field on the day, so no fee applicable, so by entering online/signing the entry form competitors are declaring they accept this.

This class is a qualifier for the **NPS Scotland Kilmannan Novice Ridden Mountain & Moorland Championship**. Ponies **must** wear snaffle bit. The **2** highest placed ponies, not already qualified, in each novice class will qualify for the Final which will take place at Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Friday 25th August 2023. Qualifications to go no lower than 4th place.

This class is also a qualifier for the **NPS/Dargavel M & M Young Ridden Pony National Championship qualifier** to be judged under **National Pony Society Rules**

This class is also a qualifier for the **NPS/COOPER FAMILY M&M Junior Ridden National Championship qualifier** to be judged under **National Pony Society Rules**. Riders must not have attained their 18th Birthday before 1st January in the current year.

NPS Scotland/Maggie May Junior Open Ridden Championship. A qualifier will be awarded to the highest placed Junior within the Open Ridden Class provided that the pony is a mare or gelding (No Stallions). The Junior must be the correct age for the pony they are riding (Large Breeds – under 18 years on 1st January in the current year). The Highest placed Junior Ridden Pony, in the Open Ridden Class not already qualified, will qualify for the Final which will take place at The Blair Castle International Horse Trials 2024. Qualifications to go no lower than 4th place.

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the Best Pure-Bred Ridden Pony in the Show. If the Champion Pony has already qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification goes to the Reserve Champion Pony Qualification to go no lower than first Reserve. The qualifying owner need not be a member of the NPS to qualify at this show. If the owner of the qualifying pony is not an NPS member they must become one before entering the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show August 2024 or at NPS Scotland Championships at Blair. Qualifiers may only compete in one final.

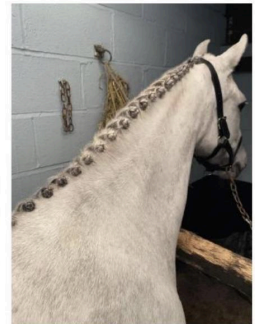
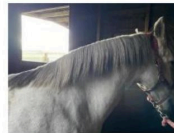
My diary is back open for 2024!

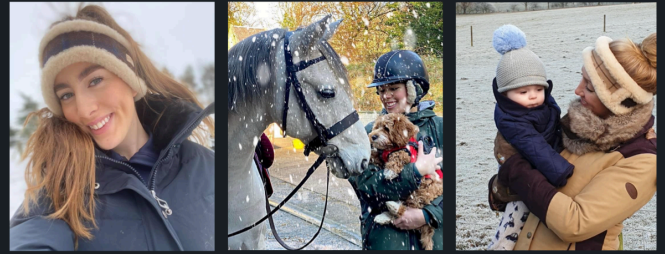

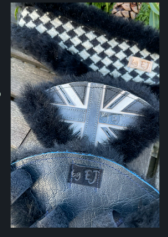
